What are the benefits of membership?

Membership also enables connection to the wider UK Unitarian family, and all it has to offer.

Would I have to come every Sunday?

No! We do not expect you to come every Sunday (although we'd love to see you often), nor make you sign up to things that you do not want to do.

What would I be expected to contribute?

We hope you will bring your ideas, your energy and enthusiasm to make this community your own. We ask that members support our community by attending and participating in services, supporting events and activities, and contributing financially, where possible.

We acknowledge that 'giving' occurs in a variety of ways and we encourage members to give within their means. In terms of financial giving, members are asked to give annually what they can - there is no set membership fee or donation required.

Any conditions or stipulations ?

In order that we get to know each other we ask that you engage with us for at least six months before applying for membership. We also ask that you are over 17 years of age and can support the vision and values of our community.
