## **Gellionnen Chapel Coronavirus Guidelines**

Hello everyone,

As a result of government regulations concerning the coronavirus pandemic, we need to make you aware of the following:

- If you would like to attend a Sunday Service, you need to contact our Secretary Sandra Beynon (07964 943246 or email [sandyb.foraniwel@gmail.com](mailto:sandyb.foraniwel@gmail.com)) and provide your contact details. We will need to follow this process each week.
- In line with government guidance, there will be live music but no singing. Similarly, there will no refreshments after the service.
- In line with new government guidance (11/9/2020) the wearing of face masks will be compulsory for all except the service leader and those with exemption for health reasons (e.g. asthma).
- We are operating a one-way system, with entry through the first door and exit through the second door.
- Seating will be by household and clearly marked with a numbering system.
- When you arrive, you will be greeted by a steward at the graveyard gate, who will explain what you need to do. At the chapel door, a second steward will offer you hand sanitiser. A third steward will confirm your name and tell you where you will be seated.
- Normally, we can accommodate 150+ people. With social distancing, our maximum capacity is 35. Therefore it is very important that we know who is coming beforehand, as we would hate to be forced to turn anyone away on a Sunday.
- The toilet will be available and will be cleaned by a volunteer in between each use.
- The chapel will need to be cleaned by volunteers following each Sunday Service.
- We know that not everyone will feel ready or able to return to in-person services. If you would rather continue attending services and events by Zoom, please let Sandra know. For now, we will continue to offer Thursday night Pub Club via Zoom, as well as other online events.

*If you or someone you live with has any symptoms before a Sunday Service, do not attend. Similarly, if you or someone you live with has any symptoms after a Sunday Service, contact Sandra immediately.*
